A professional looks at that valley and sees a high-velocity water cannon. We know that water coming down a steep valley will overshoot a standard corner. We install splash guards and increase the channel width to catch the flow. The handyman's work overflows in the first storm; ours captures the water.

Consider the layout. A handyman puts downspouts where it's easy. A professional puts them where the hydraulic load demands it. We calculate the square footage of roof draining into each section. If you have a massive roof section funneling into a tiny 10-foot run of gutter, a single standard downspout will choke. We upgrade the outlet size or add secondary drops.

The materials differ too. The stuff you buy at the big box store is thin gauge. It bends under a ladder. The seamless aluminum we extrude on-site is thicker and structurally rigid. It's designed to hold weight, not just water.
